Quarantine Support for Food and Agricultural Workers

If you are a farmworker or food processing worker who has COVID-19 or has been around someone who has COVID-19, you may be able to receive quarantine support.

Your information is kept safe and you won't be asked about your immigration status.

Call to see if you qualify.

Quarantine support includes:

- A hotel room or in-home support for up to 14 days
- Financial assistance of \$500-\$1,000
- Free meals
- Free transportation
- Free wellness checks
- Free laundry service
