Focus:

As an assemblymember who is also experienced in urban planning, Carrillo advocates for affordable housing (i.e., to address and resolve the homelessness crisis), renovating and relocating businesses (i.e. to attract new families, outside investors, and local tourism), improving/supporting community and local businesses (i.e., to create more job opportunities and improve the local economy), increasing green spaces with shade structures (e.g., developing more regional parks and open spaces with shade for public recreational use like an indoor soccer facility, planting multiple trees into dog parks, and building more shade structures for kids playgrounds), supporting local small businesses (particularly those affected by the COVID-19 pandemic), reinforcing infrastructures (i.e., to strengthen public safety like creating a safe route from residential areas to school for students), expanding access to health care, being a progressive voice (i.e., constantly fighting for social justice equity, worker equity, and equal representation for all in the State Legislature), improving the accessibility of the education system (i.e., having equal opportunity to affordable, quality education by investing into public schools and implementing more vocational training programs), combatting against the climate crisis, developing local jobs, and strengthening the 21st-century workforce (i.e., improving the workforce development by creating pipelines for the youth).

Carrillo, who immigrated from Mexico to the United States when he was 15 years old, worked his way through school as a dishwasher to become a city planner for the City of Palmdale and, when he won the 2022 General Election as the Assemblymember for the 39th District, he believes that his journey is the epitome of the American Dream. For this reason, Carrillo advocates for “every person deserves an equal shot at success” that is ensuring that every individual has the equal opportunity to live the American Dream, regardless of their background.
