Focus:

As a Latina assemblymember, Reyes advocates for women’s rights to their reproductive health, improving economic development (i.e., supporting small businesses), pro-environmental votes (i.e., supporting clean transportation, energy/resources, air, and water programs), strengthening public safety (i.e., criminal justice reforms, expanding COVID-19 health services, and implementing mandatory childhood screenings for lead exposure), increasing the funding for Inland Empire communities, affordable housing (i.e., providing more opportunities for homeownership and rent relief extension plans to reduce homelessness), improving youth and family engagement in state government, extending worker protections and representation (e.g., protecting all school employees, and implementing the CalWORKS assistance program, for those that are under/unemployed and low-income families), LGBTQ+ equality and rights, expanding health care (e.g., dementia care, and supporting the transition of childcare services and development programs to achieve affordable childcare), expanding affordability of education (i.e., ensuring equal educational opportunity for all and assisting high school seniors with tuition costs through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the California Dream Act Application (CADAA)), empowering and supporting veterans, infrastructure improvements (e.g., developing safe routes to school for youth pedestrians), increasing the support, equity, and inclusion in vulnerable communities (e.g., assisting immigrant families separated at the U.S. border and providing food resources for low-income San Bernardino residents during the COVID-19 pandemic), and improving workforce development and job creation (e.g., proving employment opportunities to inmate firefighters).

Reyes’ determination, perseverance, and conviction to succeed has enabled her to be a voice for the voiceless and an asset for those who require legal representation but cannot afford it. With the lack of access to quality legal services in her community, Reyes became the first Latina to open her own law firm, Law

Offices of Eloise Gómez Reyes, in the Inland Empire. Furthermore, the lack of access to affordable health care has also led Reyes to become the Co-Founder of the Inland Empire Community Health Center.

For her excellence in community work, Reyes was a recipient of the Wiley Pro Bono Award from the California State Bar (1988–2015) and has also been recognized as “Attorney of the Year” by the Inland Empire Latino Lawyers Association.
