Focus:

As an assemblymember with 30+ years of experience as a first responder, Rodriguez advocates for improving and strengthening local public safety (i.e., expanding Neighborhood Watch programs and requiring schools to place trauma kits and implementing a mandatory 'STOP FOR BLEED' training, including instruction in bleeding control methods, as a standard part of the high school health curriculum to empower and train students to address the mass shootings crisis), strengthening emergency preparedness (i.e., requiring the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) and the Department of Water Resources (DWR) jointly establish and lead the Extreme Weather Forecast and Threat Intelligence Integration Center), ensuring appropriate workforce for law enforcement (e.g., restoring firefighting positions and ensuring that each shift was fully staffed and properly equipped), environmental qualit, job creation through economic development projects (i.e., generating new economic investment by revitalizing downtown Pomona to attract tourism and new families), affordable housing (i.e., to reduce homelessness), balancing city budgets while protecting city services (particularly to prepare for tough economic times), and regional transportation solutions.

As an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Rodriguez has consistently advocated for public safety and workplace environment improvements for first responders within the Assembly. In the California 2021-2022 Regular Session, Governor Jerry Brown signed into law Rodriguez's Assembly Bill 69, which helps establish best practices and procedures for downloading and storing police body camera footage. For all his outstanding community volunteer contributions and lifesaving rescues such as when he traveled to Louisiana, Mississippi, and Texas to help the victims of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita in 2005, Rodriguez has received numerous awards such as the 2017 Legislator of the Year (by the Red Cross of California, Crime



Victims United - California, and the California Trucking Association), the 2015 Eleanor and Theodore Roosevelt Democrat of the Year Award (by the Los Angeles County Democratic Party), the 2014 Emergency Medical Technician of the Year (by the California Emergency Medical Services Authority), the 2014 EMT of the Year (by the California Emergency Medical Services Authority), and the California Star of Life Award.
