
As a senator, Former Major Roth advocates for improving access to higher education (e.g., extending financial assistance to summer term students at UCs and CSUs, preventing Cal Grant Programs cuts, and establishing pathways to higher education workshops in high schools), labor law reforms, increase public services in the Riverside County (including protecting schools and public colleges), strengthening veteran services (e.g., expanding Community College Veterans Resource Centers such as the California Military Institute, assisting disabled and homeless veterans via "Work for Warriors" job placement program, and honoring veterans by constructing the California Central Coast Veteran's Cemetery), expanding health care services and health care insurance (e.g., investing into mental health services, increasing access to pediatric providers, and increasing Inland SoCal's primary care provider workforce), promoting economic development (e.g., fostering business innovation to increase job creation), expanding agricultural education programs, preserving infrastructures (including historic landmarks and military bases) and conducting infrastructure projects (e.g., fixing old buildings and expanding regional parks), improving the justice system (e.g., implementing the LAW Pathways Program into K-12, community colleges, higher education partners and law schools), special education funding, drinking water supply improvements, and city funding.

To address California's primary care physician shortage, Roth championed and secured funding for the expansion of the University of California, Riverside School of Medicine (UCRSM), and its facilities. In addition to this, Roth has also supported more than \$500 million in state healthcare funding to defend women's reproductive healthcare, ensuring essential resources such as cancer screenings, life-saving treatments, and birth control/contraceptives. Currently, he serves as a Legal Advisor to the Airlift/Tanker Association, as a board member for the Air Force Judge Advocate General's School Foundation and La Sierra University Foundation, and as an active member of the Riverside Police Foundation.
